Aesthetic Medical Pathway for Malaysian Medical Doctors



Malaysian Medical Doctors who intend to practice Aesthetic Medicine in Malaysia are required to fulfil certain prerequisites and then apply to sit for a board exam to attain the Letter of Credentialing & Privileging (LCP), issued by the Ministry of Health (MOH), Malaysia.

The LCP recognises the doctor's eligibility in both knowledge and skill to administer Aesthetic Medical procedures. The MOH encourages doctors to obtain the LCP as they want more doctors to partake in Aesthetic Medicine as this will limit unqualified personnel such as beauticians from administering invasive procedures.

The requirements to apply for the LCP includes:

Full registration with the Malaysian Medical Council & valid Annual Practicing Certificate.

Completed a structured training program in Aesthetic Medicine.

Completed the clinical logbook and verified by the trainer or supervisor.

2 years of experience in General Practice / Aesthetics after completing the training program.

In possession of a valid indemnity insurance.

LCP Examination PART II (Viva)

The Letter of Credentialing and Privileging will be granted by KKM's main LCP Committee upon passing the examination
